

## LEARNING OBJECTIVES

---

In this lesson, students will:

- Apply active listening skills to learn about occupations from one of the 65 career paths in MajorClarity.
- Research occupations in the platform to identify key characteristics, including --
  - Required education level
  - Average annual wage information
  - Local job growth outlook
  - Local job presence
  - Associated career work styles
  - Associated areas of knowledge
  - Related careers
- Conduct a career path test drive and rate/record compatibility

## MATERIALS

---

This lesson requires:

- Student computer access (class set of headphones/earbuds recommended)
- Web browser (*Chrome, Firefox, Edge* recommended)
- Student Worksheet (class set, digital or hard-copy)
- Career Clips Video Slide Deck
  - Link included in digital version of Student Worksheet
- Approximately 25-30 minutes of instructional time

## TASKS

---

**Instructor-guided**

- Establish expectations for assignment completion and submission.
- Distribute copies of the Student Worksheet and present or provide online access to the Career Clips Video Slide Deck presentation.
- Provide students with independent learning time to research each featured occupation in the series for the selected career path, and to complete a career path test drive and rate their compatibility.

**Student-driven**

- Apply active listening skills as you view each career clip in the video slide deck presentation.
- Complete section A of the student worksheet --
  - Record the title and two key facts or findings about each occupation in the tables on the worksheet.
- Complete section B of the student worksheet --
  - Research and record key characteristics of each occupation in the tables on the worksheet.
- Complete section C of the student worksheet --
  - Select and complete a career path test drive activity; rate your compatibility.
  - Record your results in the table on the worksheet.
